

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

This Acceptable Use Policy (“Policy”) governs the use of the AI Lawyer (X11) platform (the “Platform”).

Users must not present AI-generated outputs as official legal opinions, professional certifications, or verified regulatory advice.

Documents or materials generated by the Platform must not be falsely represented as being produced by licensed professionals unless independently reviewed and approved by such professionals.

Users are responsible for verifying the accuracy and legality of any content generated by the Platform.

5. Data and Content Responsibility

Users must ensure that any information uploaded or submitted to the Platform:

is lawful to share and process;

does not violate confidentiality obligations;

does not infringe intellectual property rights;

does not violate privacy rights of third parties.
